## Romero Catholic Academy Trust

As I shared with you last year, as a result of the Ofsted report in March 2023, the DfE has instructed the governing body to join a multi-academy trust to strengthen the support and provision for the school. The school already had an associate agreement in place with Romero Catholic Academy Trust, which is the trust the DfE has identified for the school. Staff benefited from support from the Trust throughout last year and it is hoped the school will convert on 1st November 2023. I understand this may raise some questions for parents and am only too happy to answer them; there will be an information meeting on Tuesday 3rd October at 5.00pm when you can find out a little bit more about what the Trust will be doing to support the school.
